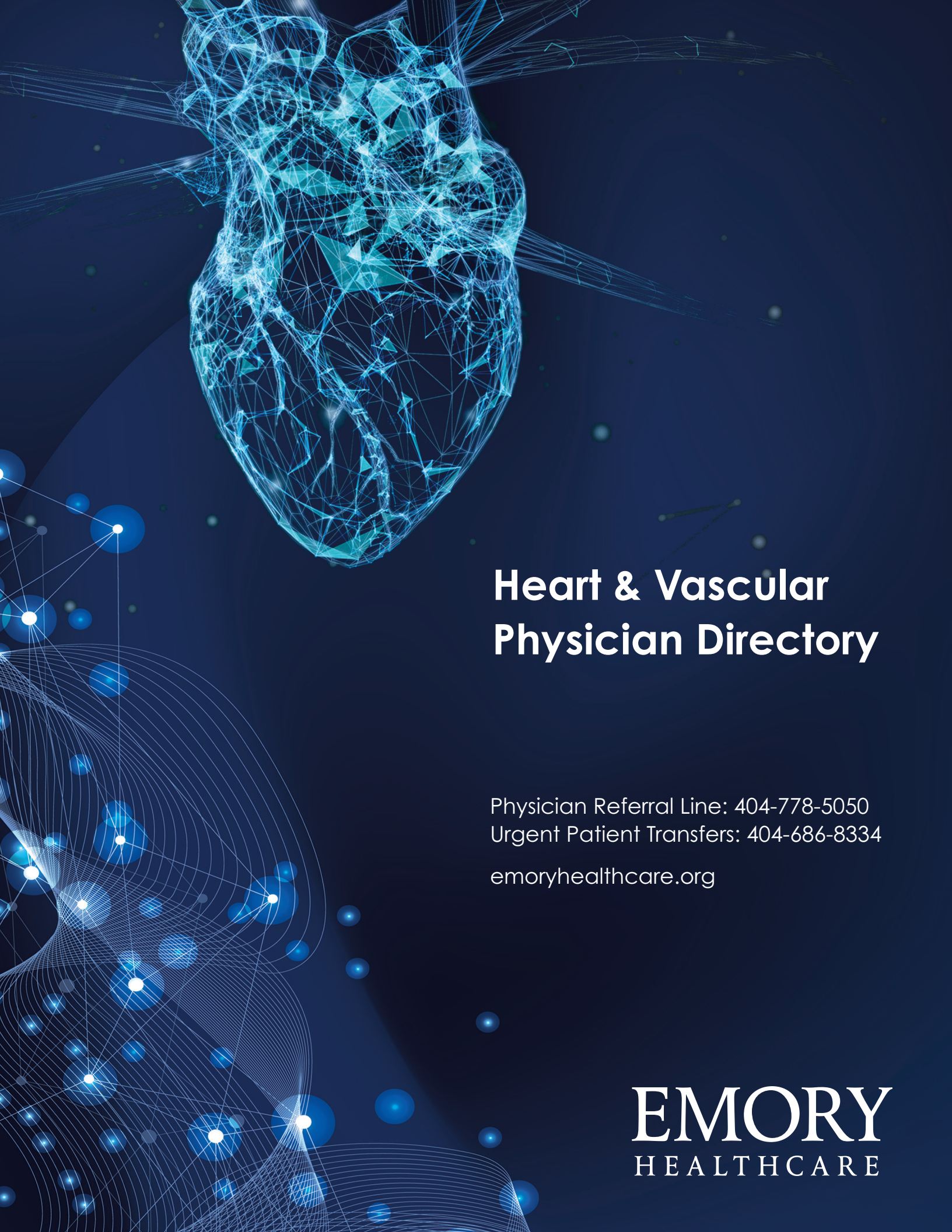

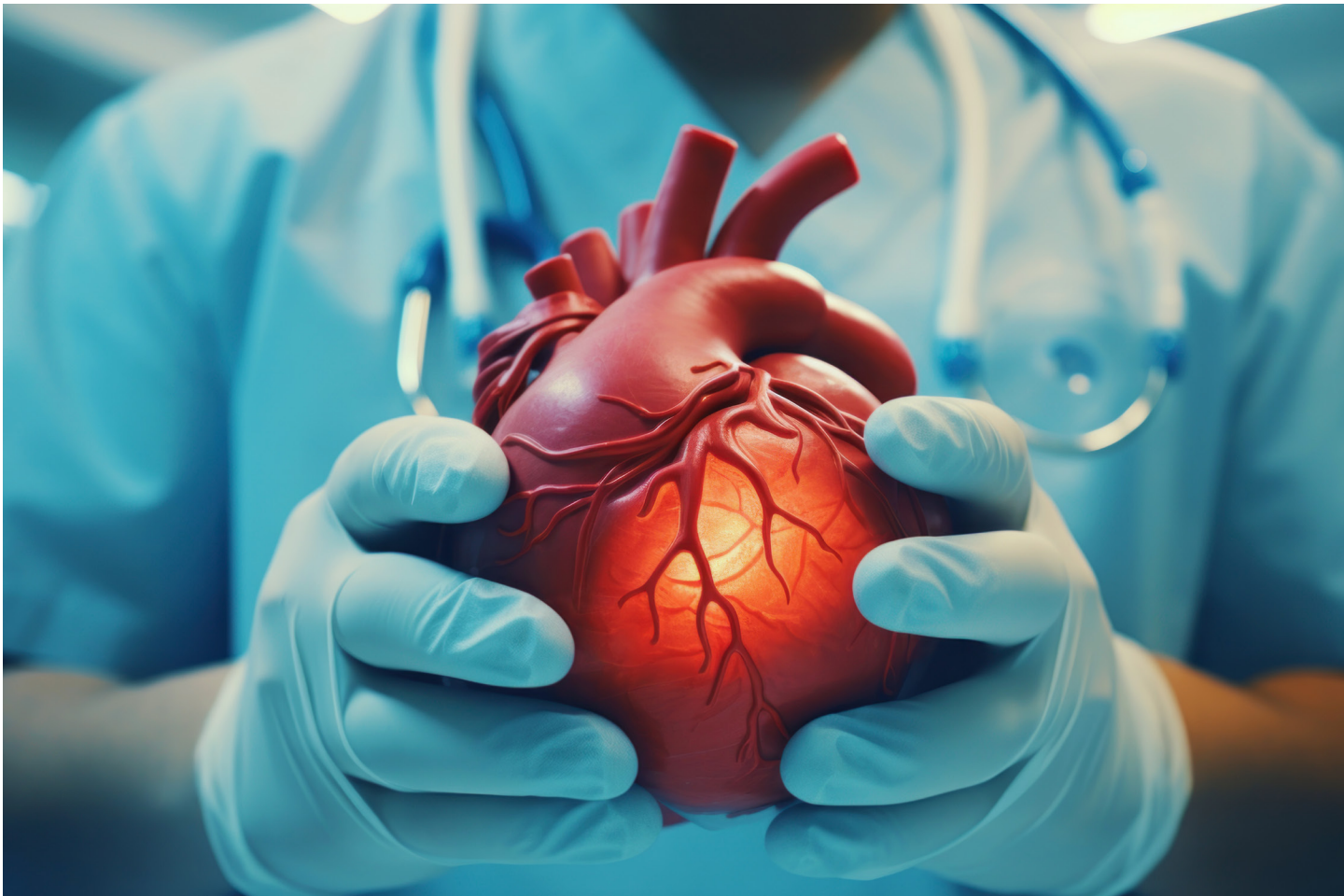
Emory's Heart & Vascular program has a national reputation for treating complicated heart conditions using the most advanced treatment options and therapies.
